KIES offers three main paths:

Path 1: THE NATURAL SCIENCE PATH: Chemistry + Physics + Biology as main subjects that can be combined with French, Business OR ICT.

Path 2: THE HYBRID PATH: Physics + Biology+ ICT or Art + Business OR French. Chemistry can also be added.

Path 3a: THE SOCIAL SCIENCE PATH: Economics + ICT + Business as main subjects that can be combined with French

Path 3b: THE SOCIAL SCIENCE PATH: Economics + ICT OR Art + French OR Business Studies
